- * **Entries close Saturday, August 11, 2018.**
- * Van Wert County exhibitors must have exhibits in place by Thursday August 30, 2018, at 6:00pm and will be released on Tuesday, September 4, 2018, at 8:00am.
- * Includes only Registered Stock or that eligible for registry, except Class 814.
- * Out of county exhibitors cannot arrive prior to Sunday, September 2, 2018, at 6:00am and must be in place by 3:00pm, that day. Out of county exhibitors will be released following the show on Monday, September 3, 2018.

Rules of Eligibility:

- 1) **Read the General Rules, Exhibits section of this book.**
- 2) Entry Fee is \$5.00 per entry, including group classes, which includes a feed pen.
- 3) The quality, density, length, quantity, and evenness of wool and the perfection of form and size to be especially considered.
- 4) Animals without quality and showing neglect will receive no premiums. See paragraphs 3, 4, and 5 of the General Rules.
- 5) A Breeders Young Flock shall consist of one(1) yearling ram or ram lamb, two(2) yearling ewes, and two ewe lambs, owned by exhibitor.
- 6) A pen of lambs shall consist of two (2) ram lambs and two (2) ewe lambs, owned by the exhibitor.
- 7) All exhibitors must be prepared to show certificates of registration upon request, and all Yearlings must have registration papers.
- 8) All sheep six (6) months old or over must be eligible to be registered in their respective registers and have the record label in their ears.
- 9) No exhibitor can make more than one (1) entry in Breeder's Young Flock, Pen of Lambs, and Pair Classes.
- 10) Each exhibitor may enter more than two (2) animals per class, but only two (2) premiums will be paid per exhibitor per class.
- 11) Sheep Health Requirements now available in this premium book, at the Fair Office, or online at www.ohioagriculture.gov.
- 12) **All Rams and Ewes must have USDA Scrapie ID Tag.**
- 13) All sheep must be shown in the ring to receive premiums.
- 14) **All sheep entered in Commercial Crossbred Class must be slick shorn.**
- 15) Show order will be posted at the show arena the day of the show.
- 16) **TRAILERS NOT ALLOWED TO BE PARKED IN BARN AREA.**
- 17) Premiums will be mailed.
- 18) Entries will close when barn is full.

Rules of Eligibility:

- 1) Read the General Rules, Exhibits section of this book.**
- 2) Muzzles are NOT allowed on Market Lambs.
- 3) Lambs must have their lamb teeth.
- 4) Market Lambs must not have any paint on them.
- 5) Carpet is NOT allowed in Market Lamb Pens.
- 6) Lambs entered in this class only will be released as soon as show is over

- 7) Maximum of twenty (20) lambs per ring. Top two (2) lambs from each ring will show for Champion and Reserve Champion.
- 8) All animals will be weighed. Exhibitors must show their animals by weight classes. Classes start at 90 pounds.
- 9) Membership Certificate or Season Ticket is NOT required to enter this class only. Daily gate admission will be charged at the gate.
- 10) All prep areas must be cleaned up.
- 11) Health Requirements available in Fair Office or online at **www.ohioagriculture.gov**.
- 12) Premiums for the top two (2) lambs of this show:

Grand Champion: 200.00 & Rosette

Reserve Champion: 100.00

- 13) The decision of the Market Lamb Committee will be final.**
- 14) The committee will accommodate everyone, but will not guarantee holding pens for this show.
- 15) Market Lambs are NOT allowed in Sheep Barn East of Show Arena.
- 16) All Lambs must have USDA Scrapies ID tags.
