**Enter Fairgrounds Through Gate 4 (Fox Road)**

The 83rd annual Rabbit Show is sponsored by the Van Wert County Agricultural Society, with the help of the Van Wert County Youth Rabbit Club. Neither the Van Wert County Agricultural Society nor the Van Wert County Youth Rabbit Club is responsible for damage to rabbits entered, but every precaution will be taken to protect entries from any possibility of danger such as fire, theft, etc.

**Rules of Eligibility:**

- 1) **Read the General Rules, Exhibits section of this book.**
- 2) Entry fee is \$2.00 for each single entry, also \$2.00 for meat pen and single fryer. \$1.00 for fur class, and must be shown in regular class.
- 3) Daily outside gate admission fee of \$7.00 is charged per exhibitor.
- 4) Entries may be made on the day of the show. Early entries taken until 10:00am. Late entries until 11:30am.
- 5) All animals must be permanently and legibly ear marked in the left ear or the judge will eliminate them.
- 6) The sponsors have the right to substitute judges as needed.
- 7) All exhibitors are responsible for getting their own animals to the show table. Adults are NOT to place rabbits on or off the show table for the youth.
- 8) No breeding allowed in the show room.
- 9) An animal may be shown in either open or youth class, not both.
- 10) We reserve the right to refuse any entry that is sick or diseased.  
Any animal found to be sick or diseased must be removed from the barn or Show Arena.
- 11) **Exhibitors may sell day of show, Saturday, September 1, 2018.**

- 13) Premiums will be mailed.
- 14) All sanctioned breed are early entry and all non-sanctioned breeds are late entry.
- 15) This is a chartered ARBA show and governed by the current show rules of the ARBA, using the ARBA forms and cards.
- 16) Neither the sponsoring club nor the Van Wert County Agricultural Society is responsible for damage to rabbits entered, but every precaution will be taken to protect entries from any possibility of danger such as fire, theft, etc.
- 17) Checks payable to: Van Wert County Agricultural Society.
- 18) A show display shall consist of six (6) or more entries in any one or more breeds.
